



## NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED ELECTRIC WORK IN AREA

Location: **Forrester Blvd. / Royal Ridge Dr., Burke, VA**

Dear Customer:

Dominion Virginia Power is in the process of replacing cable in your neighborhood. This project is necessary to improve service reliability and to upgrade our facilities to meet the growth and demand for electricity that we are experiencing in this area.

While we do not wish to inconvenience you during this replacement process, it may be necessary for us to cut and remove ground along the cable path. This could include some areas of your lot. Cable will be replaced within the existing Virginia Power easement that may run along or across your property. All areas disturbed will be restored.

Before the work starts, we ask that customers mark all privately owned underground facilities (i.e., electric fences, sprinkler systems, low voltage lighting, ect.), within the Virginia Power underground easement. Trimming or removing of shrubbery planted around the pad-mounted transformers may be necessary. We know customers invest much effort and money in landscaping and may prefer to do this trimming or moving. Landscaping should allow the following minimum clearances for safe operating conditions: 1) Ten feet in front 2) Three feet along the sides and back.

In the event a service interruption is necessary, we will attempt to limit it to only a few hours. Our representative will be in contact regarding the actual date and time of the service interruption. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions or concerns regarding the above.
